Police Safety advice

District Inspector Ian Trueman and PCSO Knights attended the Parish Council meeting on October 24th. They advised that as the evenings are now getting darker, and the clocks are about to go back, residents should be aware of some basic safety advice to keep their homes protected. Keeping lights on and using timers for lights and radios can aid in making a house appear occupied even when it is not. Also, double checking that side gates are locked is an easy precaution to take. Burglary tends to rise at this time of the year and if any resident is worried then they can contact PCSO Knights to arrange a free Crime Prevention Survey
