## **Armistice Day**

Bishopstoke Parish Council would invite all residents to attend the Armistice Day service on Glebe Meadow to mark the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the end of World War 1. The service takes place on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> November. We expect to begin proceedings at 10:45 so please gather in the Meadow at the back of the Memorial Hall from around 10:30. The wreaths will be laid as usual by the War Memorial and then following the ceremony there will be a parade up to St Marys Church where the service will continue.

### Lest We Forget

A series of "Lest We Forget" silhouettes has been installed around the village to help mark the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the end of World War 1. A Royal Flying Corp Airman has been placed at St Pauls Church, a Suffragette has been installed at the Cemetery, and the steps of the Memorial Hall are now flanked by a Silent Soldier and a Sailor.

### **Bishopstoke Carnival**
