

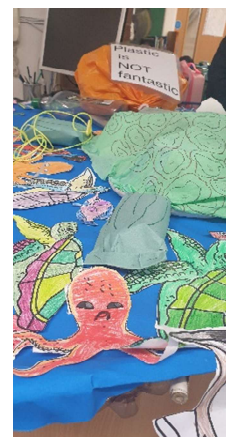
## What to do this summer . . .

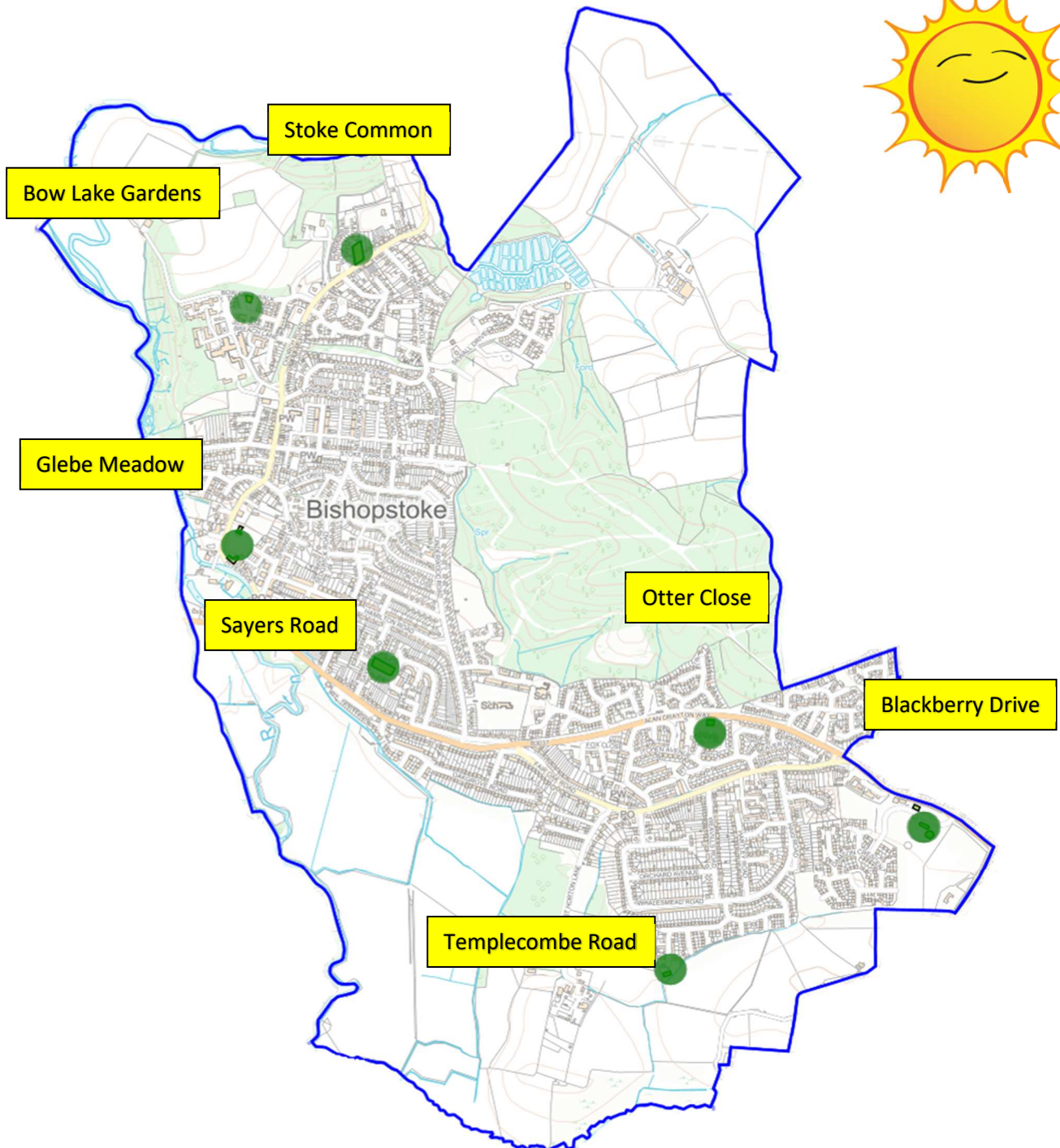


# Explore the play parks of Bishopstoke

That's 7 days of fun for you!


## **STOKE COMMON PLAY AREA**


## **GLEBE MEADOW PLAY AREA**

A large, empty rectangular box with a thin black border, intended for a pencil rubbing of the Glebe Meadow Play Area.


## **SAYERS ROAD PLAY AREA**

A large, empty rectangular box with a thin black border, intended for a pencil rubbing of the Sayers Road Play Area.


## **OTTER CLOSE PLAY AREA**


## **TEMPLECOMBE ROAD PLAY AREA**


## **BLACKBERRY DRIVE PLAY AREA**
