

Other News

New Allotments

For some time now the Parish Council has been waiting for two new allotment sites being provided as part of the developments by the Cemetery and off Bow Lake Gardens. We hope that Bow Lake Gardens could be with us by this Autumn and as soon as we have confirmation we will contact everyone on the waiting list to let them know. Progress has been slower at the Sewall Drive site, but we are hoping for good news soon.

Travel Tokens

If you, or someone you know, doesn't have access to a family car, and struggles to use the bus service (either because they can't get on the bus or simply because the bus stop is too far away) you might be eligible for Travel Tokens. Each token is worth £1 towards the cost of a ride with One Community's Dial-a-ride, the Bishopstoke and Fair Oak Good Neighbours, and some local taxi firms. A New Village Hall

Exciting plans are taking shape for a new village hall that will come to fruition over the coming years, and your councillors have been busy looking at various options concerning layout and orientation. The Borough Council has agreed to contribute well over £1m towards this and we are working hard to get grants for the balance needed.

The current Memorial Hall is in very poor shape, and is uninsurable. Reluctantly, the decision has therefore been taken to demolish the existing hall to make way for the new one. This does mean however that the Council will be able to look afresh at the whole Glebe Meadow area and offer a range of facilities for the village that residents can be really proud of.

In addition to the planned new Memorial Hall, Glebe Meadow will see a number of other changes in the next few years. These include a new toddler play area, a new skate park, moving the War Memorial, a new sensory garden and a new entrance at Portal Road.

With the creation of the Glebe Meadow Working Group, Bishopstoke Parish Council has brought together the various projects that are planned for the Meadow under one banner. It is an exciting time for the Meadow and we are looking forward to providing a space that can be enjoyed by all members of our local community. Local Plan

Eastleigh Borough Council has recently consulted on its proposed local plan modifications following the Government Inspector's inquiry. The modifications include the removal of the policies and text referring to the building of two new settlements north of Bishopstoke and Fair Oak, which is in line with the Parish Councils' objection to this part of the plan. There is likely to be an early review of the plan to address any shortfall in housing delivery. Keep an eye on the Borough Council website, www.eastleigh.gov.uk, for the consultation results.
